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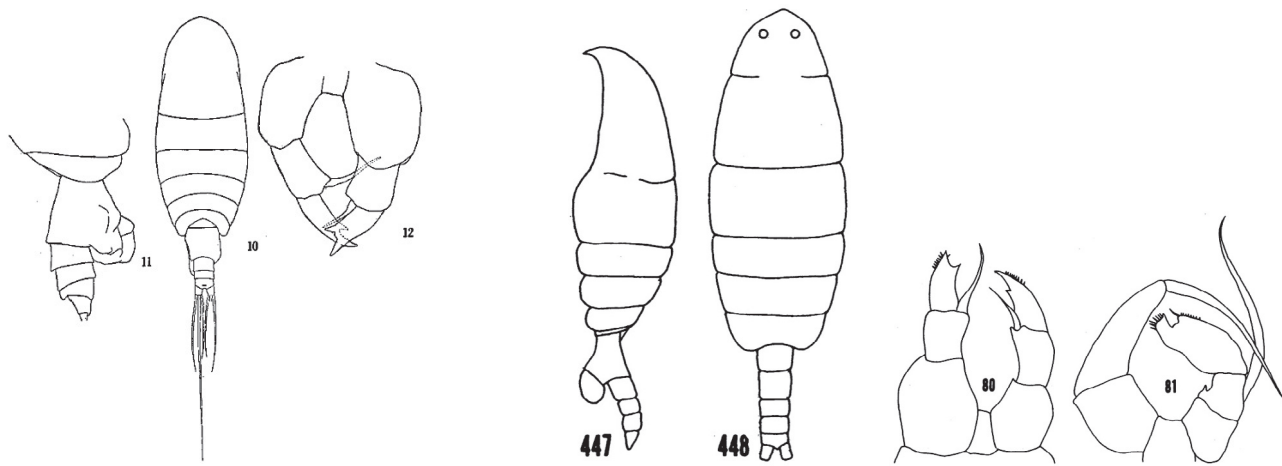
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Temoropia mayumbaensis T. Scott, 1984 (Size: female, 0.56–1.24 mm; male, 0.84–1.06 mm)
